



## **IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

Based on the COVID-19 positive cases that have stabilized within the past month with no new positive cases reported by Zuni Indian Health Services; the Zuni Incident Command **will lift** the 57-Hour Weekend Curfew **effective, Friday, September 4, 2020.**

Keep in mind, if there is an increase in COVID-19 positive cases, the 57-Hour weekend curfew **will be** reinstated. Therefore, we must continue to be vigilant in defeating COVID-19 by consistently practicing all safety precautionary measures to include: social distancing, use of face masks when in public, frequent handwashing/sanitizing, disinfecting/sanitizing high touch surfaces, limit in state and out of state travel and avoid large gatherings of 10 or more.

### Other modifications:

#### ➤ ***Effective Friday, September 4, 2020:***

- The curfew will be extended by one (1) hour. Curfew will be from **9 pm to 5 am daily.**
- All local stores/businesses have the option to remain open up until 8 pm daily and allow in-door dining at 25% maximum capacity.

### Violations:

Violation(s) of the directions outlined on the Zuni Tribal Resolution No. M70-2020-P062 may cause individuals to be charged with Public Nuisance (4-4-120), Failure to Dispense (4-4-96) and other charges as the facts may merit.
